Final follow-up breast screening appointment

This is the last time you will be invited for a follow-up breast screening appointment after your treatment for breast cancer.

If you are over 50 and under 70 after your final follow-up appointment, you will be invited to attend for routine breast screening on a mobile unit every three years. This will be at the same time as other women are invited from your GP practice.

If you are over 70 after your final follow-up appointment, you can refer yourself for routine breast screening on a mobile unit every three years.

To refer yourself, please call the Southampton and Salisbury breast screening unit. You will be given an appointment at the same time as other women are invited from your GP practice.

Results

The results of your final follow-up mammograms will be sent to your GP within two weeks of your appointment.
