Wessex Adult Cystic Fibrosis Survey Findings

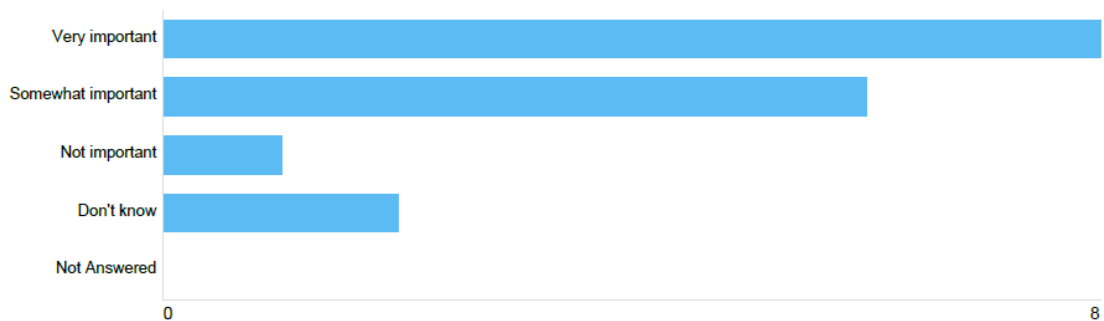
There were 17 responses to the survey. The free text responses have not been included for patient confidentiality.

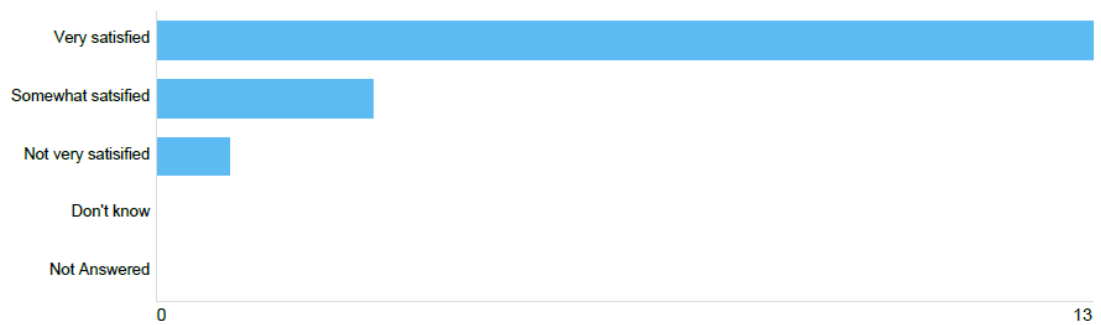

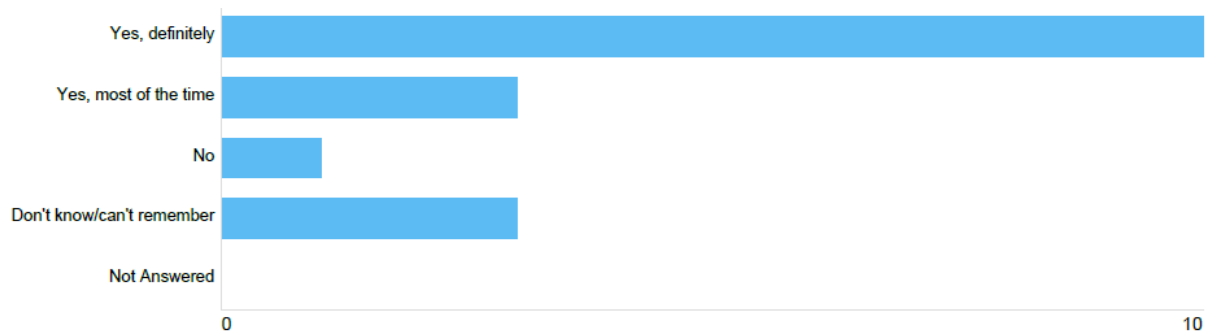
Question 4: How satisfied are you with your current level of care?

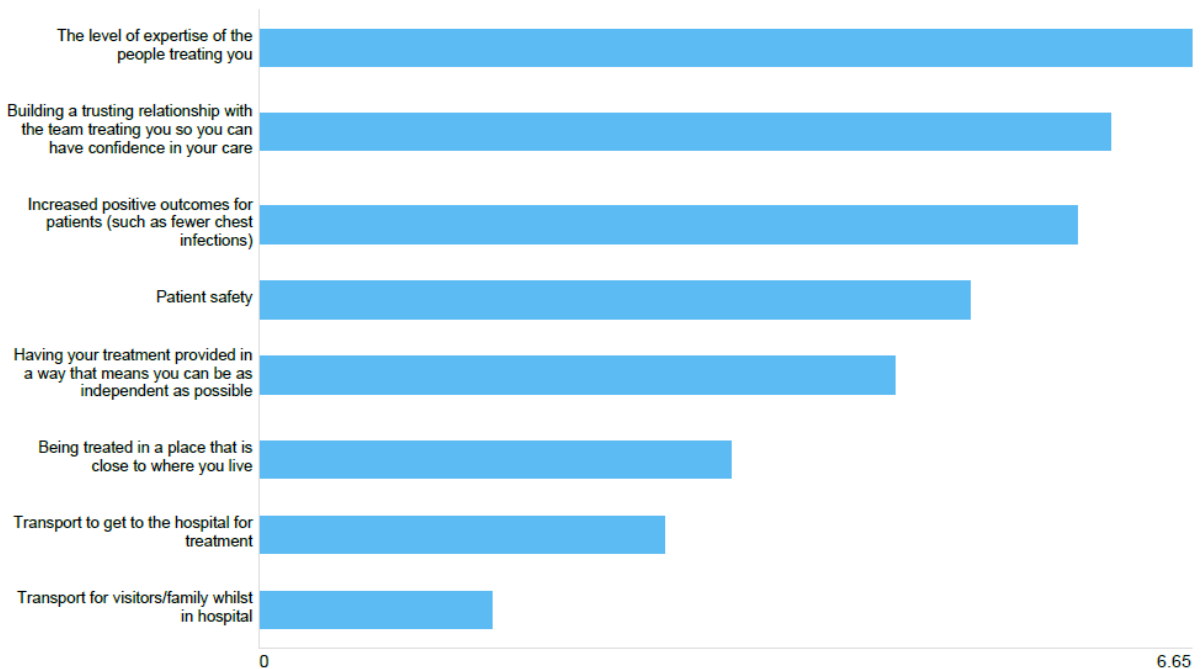
Question 5: If you, your family or someone else close to you wanted to talk to a cystic fibrosis doctor about your care, do they have enough opportunities to do so?

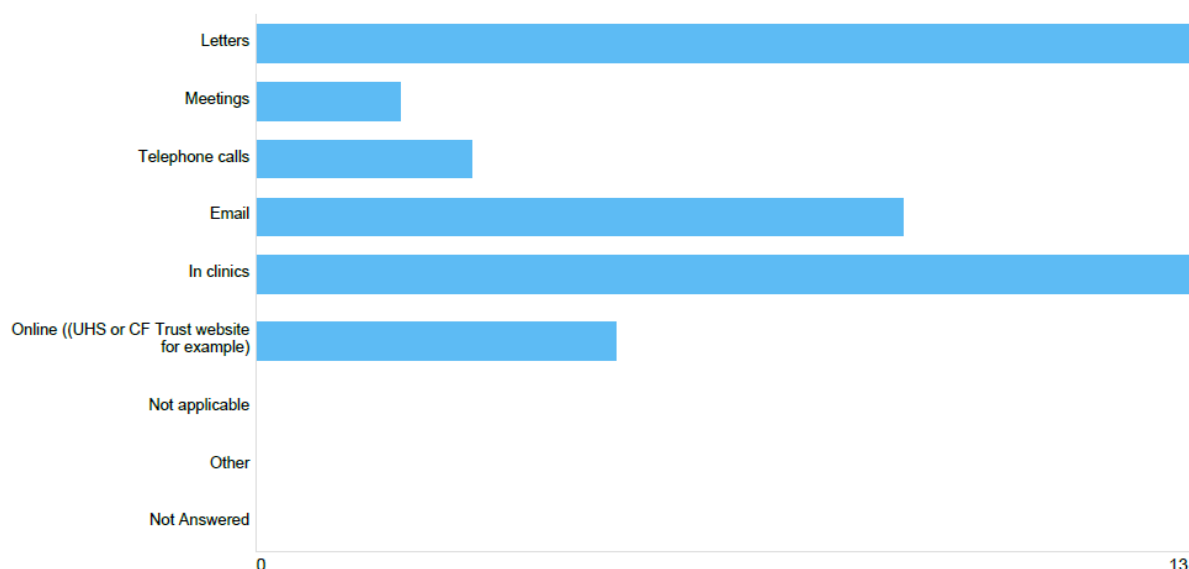

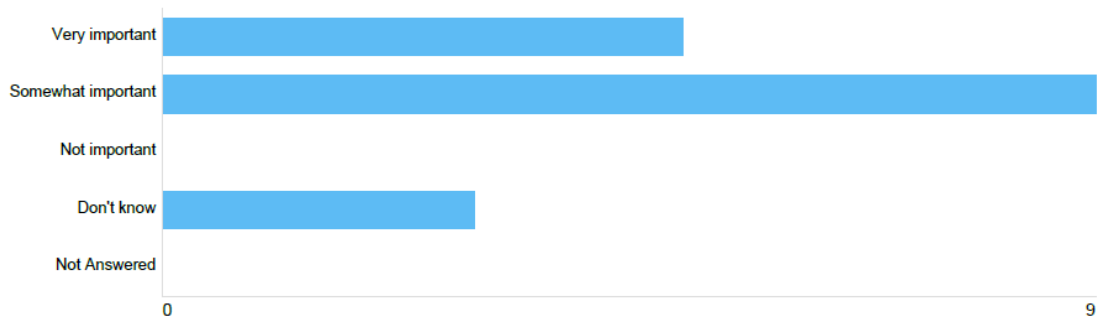
