	At the time of making this declaration the board of directors was conscious of a number of uncertainties that could affect the Trust's ability to provide the Commissioner Requested Services. These included the continuation of the COVID-19 pandemic, staff sickness and absence due to COVID-19, inflationary and other unavoidable cost pressures, a higher than normal efficiency challenge, the risks of non-delivery of elective recovery targets and the levels of demand for elective activity as both emergency department attendances and referrals for elective activity in some areas were increasing. Risks to the availability of Required Resources have been highlighted in the Trust's operating plan and budget and relate to activity and demand management and staffing and system capacity. These risks have been recorded in the Trust's risk register and are regularly monitored and reviewed together with the associated plans to manage and address these risks.					
	In approving its operating plan and budget the board of directors has taken into account the cash and reserves of the Trust, which would enable it to allocate additional resources as required, and the Trust has agreed contracts in place with commissioners for the provision of services and cost improvement plans covering this period. The Trust and other NHS and social care providers are also working collaboratively as part of the Hampshire and Isle of Wight integrated care system to address the issues of demand and activity on a collective basis.
