We are your keyworkers. Our role is to act as a key resource for patients and relatives so that you have access to expert help, information, support and advice for those having thoracic surgery and investigations.

We are available at outpatient clinics based in Southampton and Portsmouth, during your stay on ward E4 and also on the telephone.

From Monday to Friday, 9am to 4pm, you can telephone us on: 023 8120 8457

When we are not available to take your call, there is an answer phone. Please leave your name, a contact number and a short message, and we will contact you as soon as possible. If we are on annual leave or study time we will include this information in our answer phone message.

You can also bleep us during the above hours. Telephone 023 8077 7222 and ask for bleep 2949.

This is not an emergency phone line - please contact your GP or an ambulance, if the matter is more urgent. We are here to discuss details such as:

- your forthcoming admission to hospital and what to expect
- your surgery
- what investigations you will undergo and preparation before your surgery
- advice on post-operative care and expected length of stay in hospital
- length of recovery and advice for when you go home and any follow-up if required
- accommodation for relatives during your stay in hospital
- access to advice via the telephone once you are discharged from hospital

Ward information

You can telephone ward E4 direct on 023 8120 6498.

Visiting times are from 3pm to 8pm and we request only two people at the bedside at one time. We do appreciate that this may be restricting, so please discuss any particular problems or requests with the nurse in charge. We will try to accommodate these, thinking of your wellbeing and that of others.
